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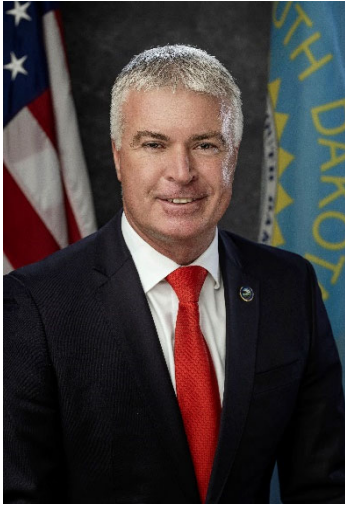
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Attorney General Jackley Notes

SOUTH DAKOTA CRIME SUMMARY 2024

In 2024, state and local law enforcement agencies reported a total of 67,959 offenses. This represents a 1.21% increase from the year prior.

Group "A" Offenses totaled 47,070 compared to 45,905 offenses reported in 2023. This represents a difference of 1,165 or 2.53% increase.

Group "B" Offenses totaled 20,888 compared to 21,240 offenses reported in 2023. This represents a difference of 352 or 1.65% decrease.

Murder increased by 72%; there were 31 homicides reported in 2024, as compared to 18 homicides reported in 2023.

Forcible Rape increased by 24 or 7.05%. There were 364 forcible rapes reported in 2024, compared to 340 reported in 2023.

There was a total of 1,777 burglaries reported in 2024. This is a 2.52% decrease from 2023 where 1,823 were reported. Thirty-Three (32.86%) percent of burglaries reported in 2024 were forced entry (584).

In 2024, juvenile arrestees accounted for 10.15% (3,776) of the total arrests (37,217), down from 3,994 in 2023, a drop of 5.45%.

The number of reported arrests in 2024 for DUI was 5,493. This represents an increase of 81 arrests or 1.49% from the total of 5,412 reported in 2023.

In 2024, 6,751 total drug offenses were reported compared to 6,315 reported in 2023, an increase of 6.9%.

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Introduction

National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) is a cooperative effort among city, county, and state law enforcement agencies with the necessary application required for crime reporting. Agencies can use our web-based software or if they have a private vendor and their own Records Management System (RMS), they may export their data and send it to the Criminal Statistical Analysis Center (SAC) on a monthly basis. The SAC then imports any data submitted by agencies. All data received either through the State's web-based system or imported is then submitted to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) where national reports, such as Crime in the United States, are generated. Every effort is made to have data submitted at the time of yearly publication. Data is live and can be retrieved at any time on the Attorney General's NIBRS website at sdcrime.nibrs.com.

Certain constraints should be noted in interpreting the collective data for the State. It must be noted that Indian Reservations are not included as they do not report crime statistics to the SAC. Indian Reservation crime data is collected directly by the FBI. Comparing data year to year gives a good picture of crime trends; however, keep in mind when comparing these figures to previous years that there is a difference in the number of agencies reporting each year. Also, these figures cannot be compared to data released by the FBI, as the FBI uses estimations for non-reported data and has a set deadline for accepting data.

Starting in 2008, the SAC only accepted NIBRS data. NIBRS is an incident-based reporting system designed to collect data on each incident and arrest within that occurrence. The most significant difference between NIBRS and the traditional summary Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) system is the degree of detail in reporting. Unlike the summary UCR system that collects data on only 8 Part I crimes, NIBRS collects 24 crime categories made up of 53 specific crimes called Group A offenses. In addition to the Group A offenses, there are 10 Group B offense categories for which only arrest data are collected. The Hierarchy Rule is not used in NIBRS. Therefore, if more than one crime was committed by the same person or group of persons and the time and space intervals separating them were insignificant, all the crimes are reported as offenses in the same incident.

Law Enforcement Employees data is obtained by the SAC every year. This figure is calculated by the number of full-time sworn law enforcement officers and full-time civilian staff who are employed by active agencies as of October 31st each year.

In NIBRS, there are no "fixed" statistics because law enforcement agencies update their incidents as new information becomes available. These figures are based on statistics that were analyzed for a twelve-month period from January 1st-December 31st each year. The data included in this report can only be as accurate as the data provided by each reporting agency.

Crime Data

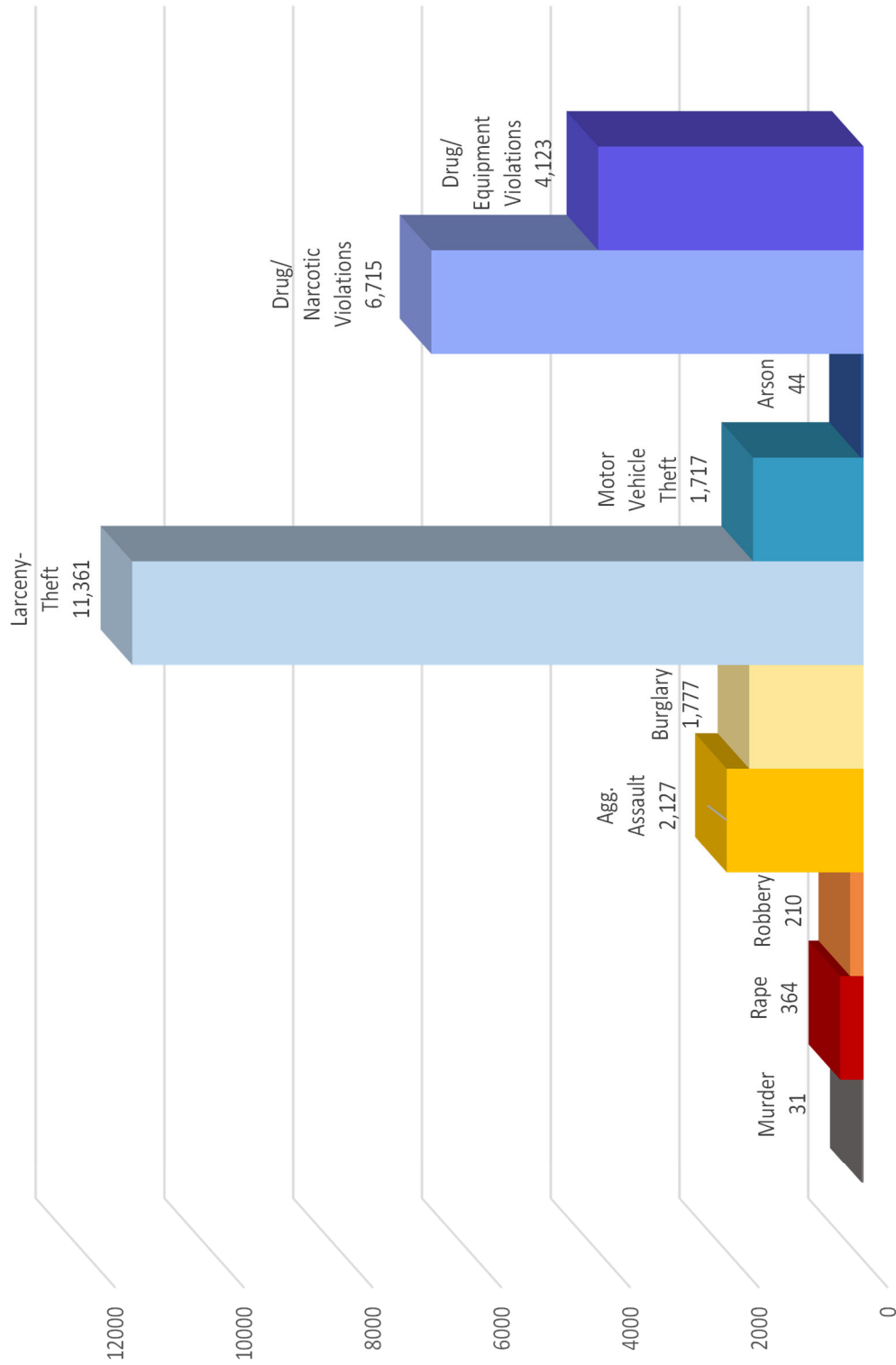
This publication includes counts for the NIBRS reported crimes of Murder and Non-Negligent Manslaughter, Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Larceny-Theft, Motor-Vehicle Theft, Arson, and Drug/Narcotic and Drug Equipment Violations. Because of their seriousness, frequency of occurrence and likelihood of being reported, all but the drug violations are regarded as an Index Crime. The first four crimes are **violent crimes** or crimes against persons. The remaining four crimes are serious **property crimes**. The drug violations are grouped as **other crime**. All remaining crimes that fall under Group A and Group B offenses can be accessed on the Attorney General’s NIBRS website at sdcrime.nibrs.com.

The following table is a profile of reported crimes for 2024 in South Dakota. This table includes calculated crime rates per 100,000 people. The use of crime rates in making comparisons in crime trends helps to minimize problems with crime data interpretation. However, readers are cautioned that crime rates cited are reliable indications of crime only to the extent that population estimates are accurate, that victims report crimes and NIBRS data is submitted to SD ATG DCI by law enforcement agencies.

PROFILE OF REPORTED CRIMES - 2024



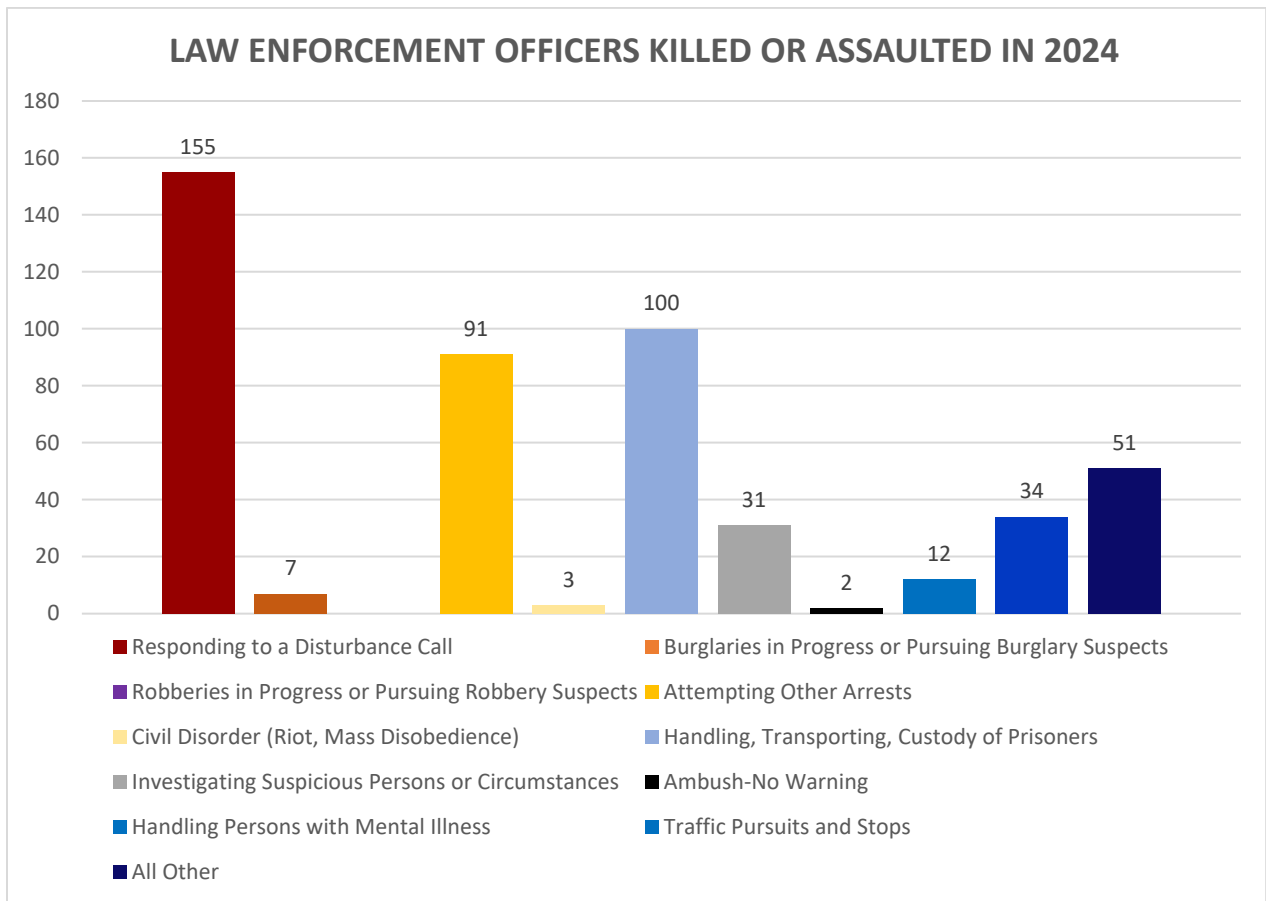

End of Watch: Friday, February 2nd, 2024

Chief Deputy Ken Prorok was killed in the line of duty on February 2nd, 2024, after being struck by a fleeing car while deploying spike strips during a criminal pursuit.

Ken began his law enforcement career at the Moody County Sheriff's Office as a dispatcher eventually becoming Deputy Sheriff of Moody County and continued his service for 8 years.

Ken was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, son, brother, uncle, coach, friend, and Deputy Sheriff. He was 51 years at the time of his death.

Ken and his wife, Renee, have three children – two daughters: Brooke, (husband Troy); Taylor, (Fiancé Dawson), and a son JD. Ken and Renee's granddaughters Hannah (4 years old) and Drew (2 years old) were Papa's little buddies.

He coached baseball, softball, and volleyball at Dakota State University in Madison. He also coached many youth sports around the local area. He coached youth basketball in Chester and youth baseball for Chester, Madison, and Sioux Falls. Ken also spent 10 years coaching Chester High School Football. Ken coached his son, JD in baseball from t-ball through the 2023 travel season.

South Dakota Attorney General Marty Jackley is prosecuting the First-Degree Murder case.

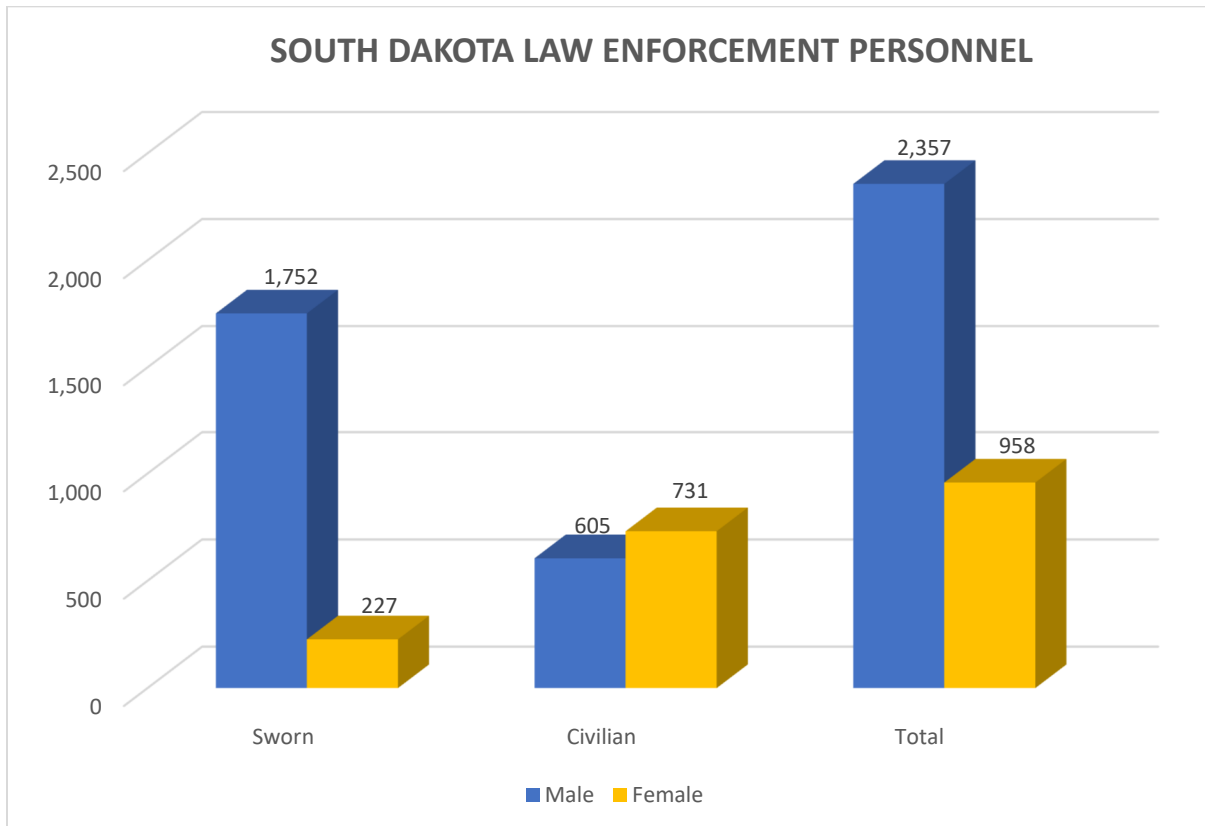

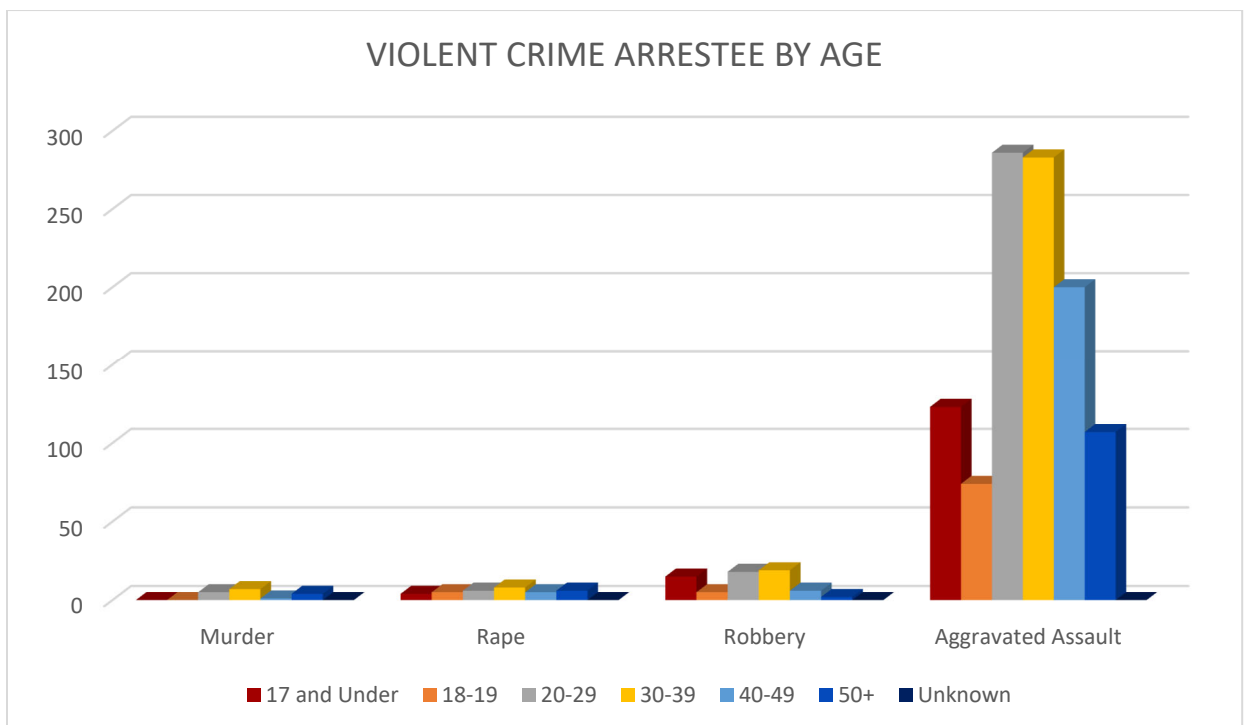

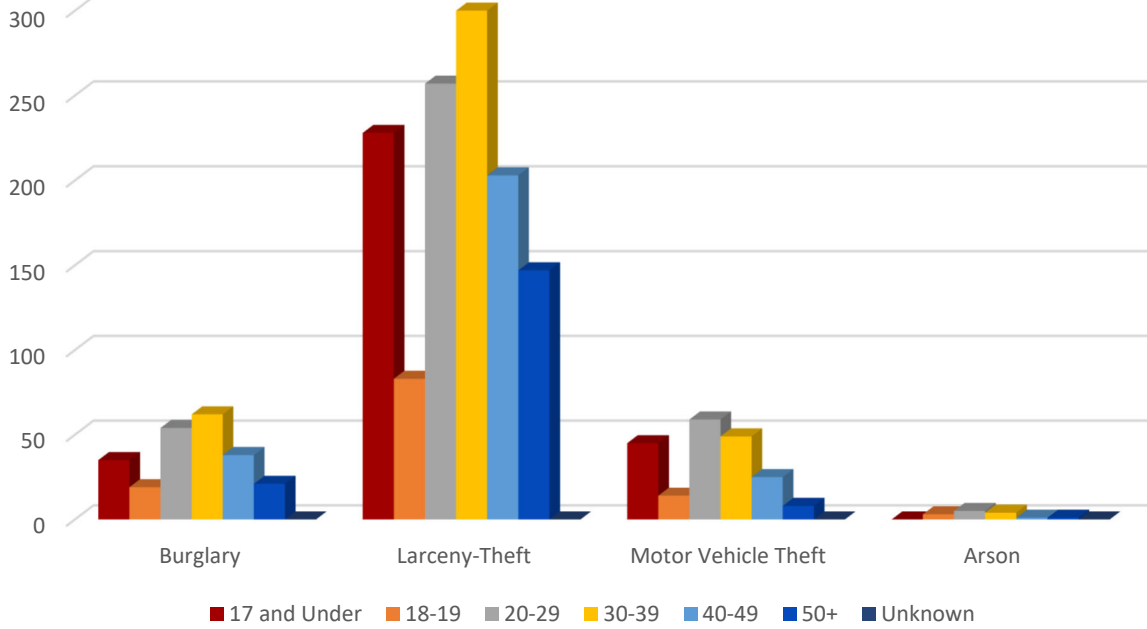

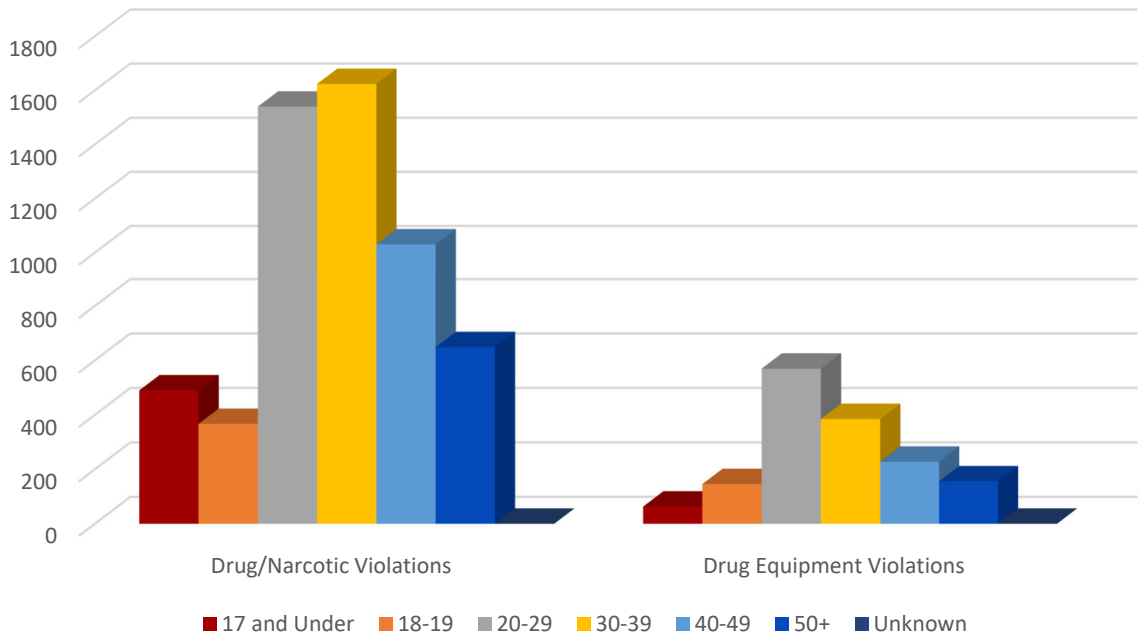

PROPERTY CRIME ARRESTEE BY AGE

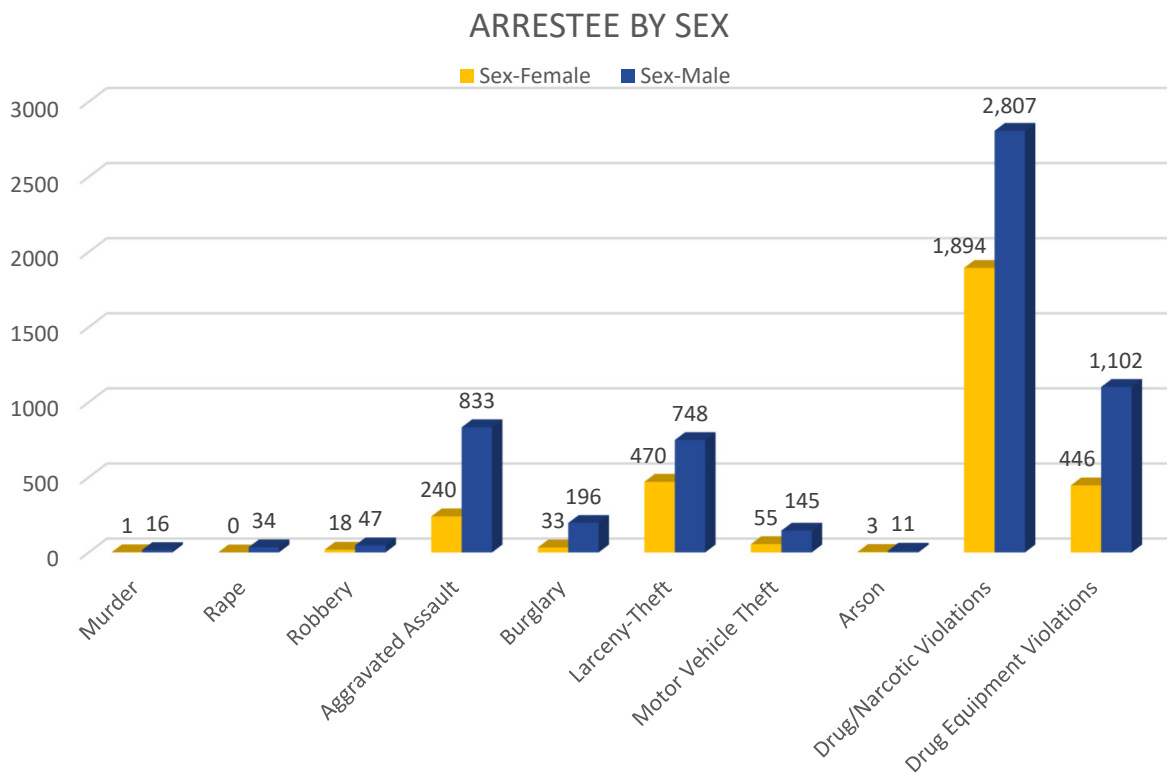

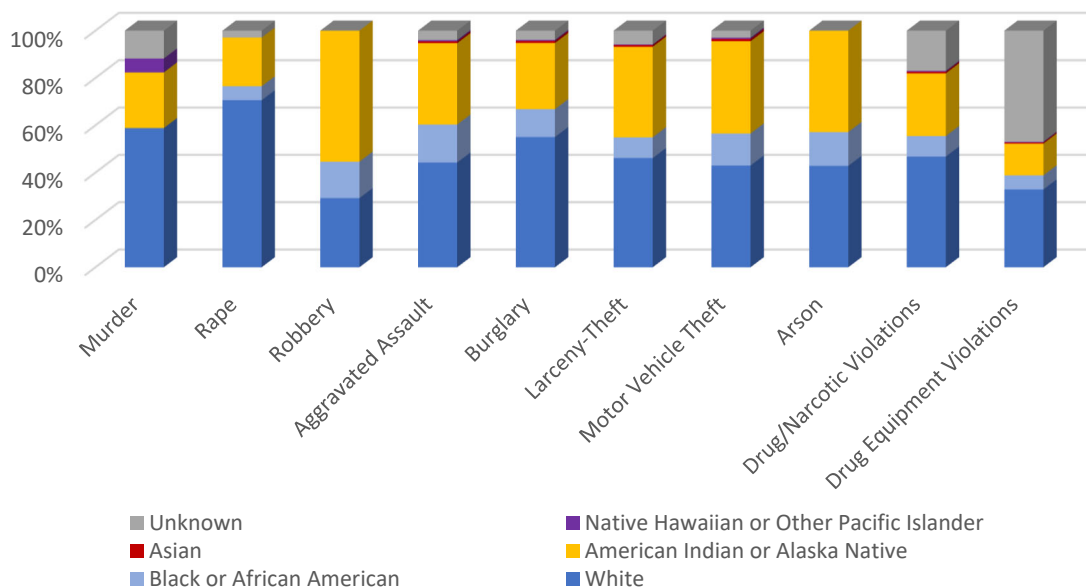

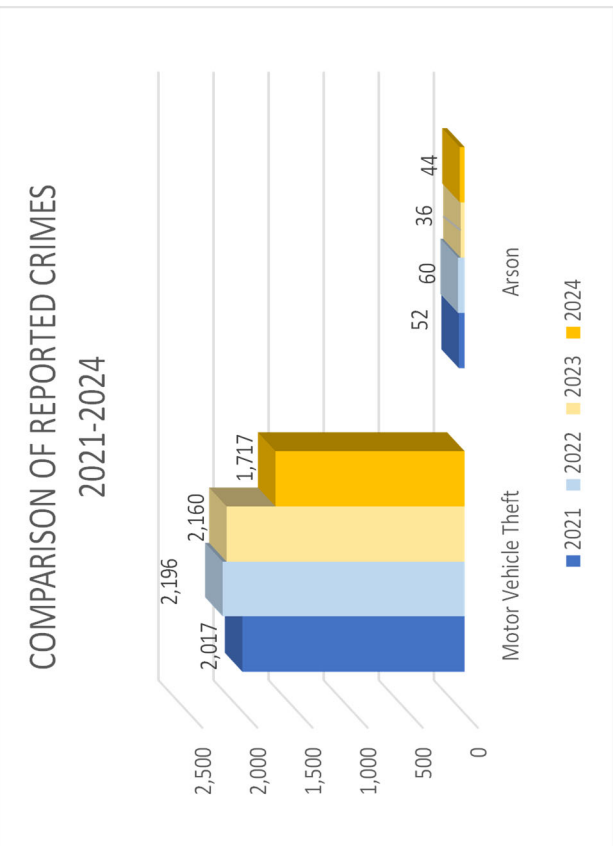
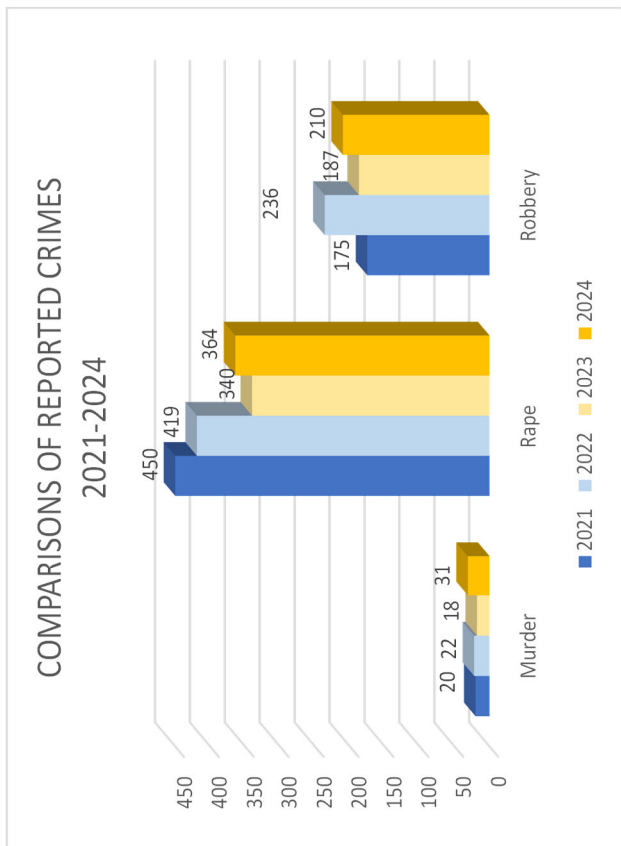
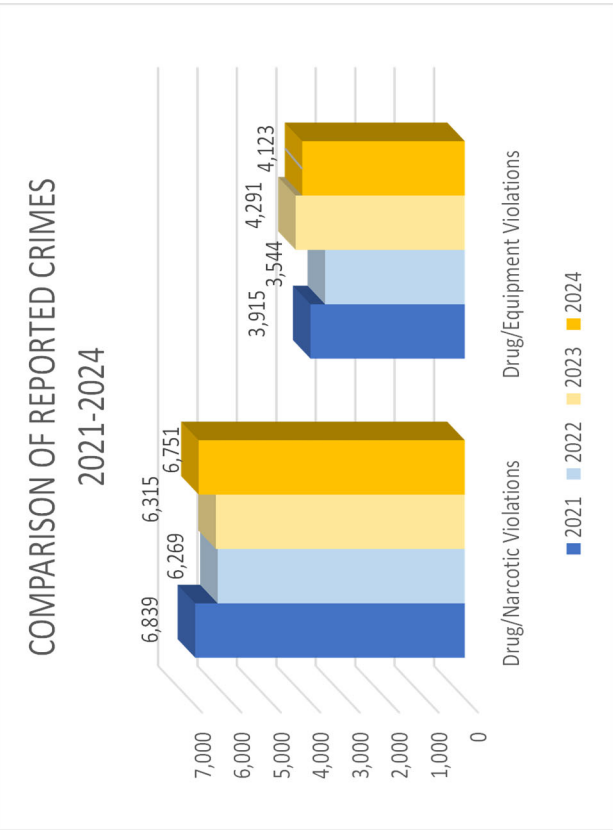
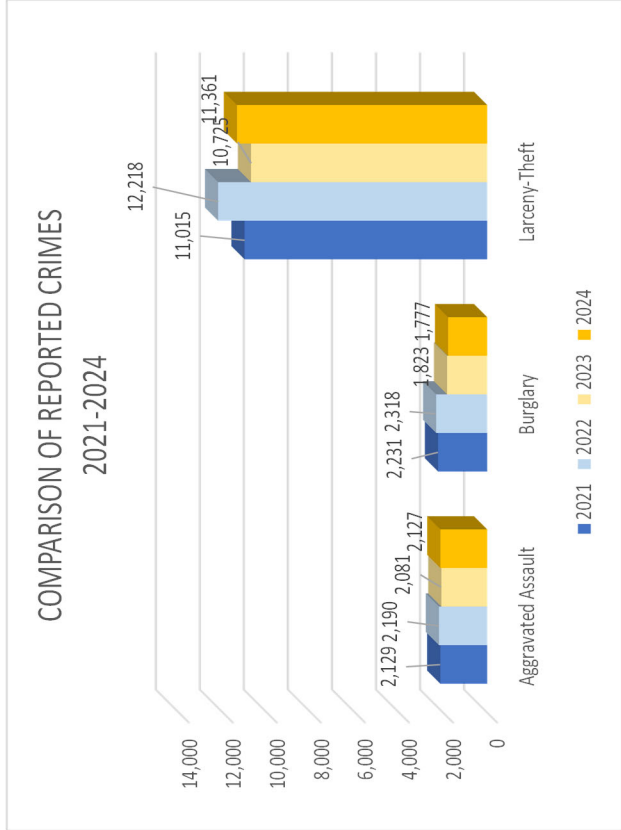


Crime and Arrest Comparisons

The table shows the number of incidents and arrests reported each year, based upon UCR criteria, between 2020 and 2023 for each of the ten crimes. While comparisons of arrests to crimes reported could be useful measurements of law enforcement activity, caution must be exercised. Arrests reported in one year may be incidents that occurred in the same year or earlier. More than one individual can be arrested for a crime or be arrested more than once during a given year. Therefore, arrest statistics reflect the number of arrests made, rather than the number of crimes solved or the number of different persons taken into custody.

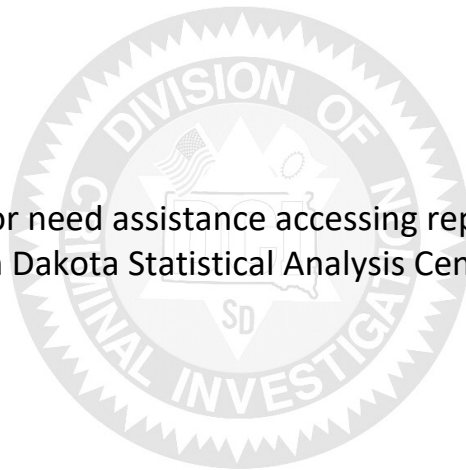
